FILM FESTIVAL 2023



The Footcandle Film Festival is returning to Hickory, North Carolina on September 15th-24th, 2023!

This will be an exciting week of film screenings with films being submitted from around the world for consideration. The best reviewed films will be shown during the weekend, starting with an opening night event and closing with an awards ceremony. The festival will be held at various locations across the community, including the Hickory Community Theatre, the SALT Block and the Carolina Theater.

Every dollar spent on this festival will go towards creating an experience that attendees, filmmakers and other visitors to the area will remember and help "spread the word" for continued festival growth next year.

This festival continues to be a showcase event for the Catawba County area, and we are making every effort to have our eighth year be just as successful as the first.

The 2023 Footcandle Film Festival will be a week-long event, including the following events and activities:

COMPETITIVE FILM SCREENINGS BY FILMMAKERS AROUND THE WORLD

The 2023 Footcandle Film Festival will screen films during the course of the festival weekend. There will be feature-length films and short films, all in a competitive field and eligible for awards determined by both judges and the audience.

The 2023 film festival is a combination in-person and online event. Attendees can choose to attend select screenings in person or watch the films online the day after their premieres.

Six awards will be presented at the end of the 2023 festival weekend: Best Narrative Feature, Best Documentary Feature, Best Narrative Short, Best Documentary Short, Audience Favorite Feature and Audience Favorite Short. The awards will announced Sunday evening via a live event.

YOUTH INTERNATIONAL SHORT FILM SHOWCASE

with the Greater Hickory International Council

The Youth International Film Festival (YIFF), hosted by the Footcandle Film Society and the Greater Hickory International Council, is a special showcase event to help expose school-age children to short films from around the world. Films are submitted from around the world, with the best selections shown in a special in-person screening event during the course of the festival week. The emphasis this year is on films for children in 4th – 8th grades.

FILMLAB FILMMAKING COMPETITION

The first year of the FilmLAB, a weekend-long filmmaking competition that invites filmmaking teams from across North Carolina to produce a short film within a 48-hour period from September 15th-17th.

On Monday, September 18th, the completed films from the FilmLAB weekend will be shown in a free event at the Drendel Auditorium on the SALT Block in Hickory, North Carolina. Each of the filmmaking teams will shares their experiences making the films with the audience in a discussion following the screening.



SCRIPTWRITING COMPETITION

The Footcandle Film Festival will be holding the fifth year of the Footcandle Scriptwriting Competition in 2023. Film script submissions from filmmakers around the world were accepted earlier in the year, and a committee reviews all applications and selects winners for this year's awards. The script submissions were for feature-length films, with all submissions being scripts for films that have yet to be produced at this time. The awards will be presented at a special event at the SALT Block with a talk from each of the winners about their experience and background in scriptwriting.



SIGHT AND SOUND

For the first time, the Footcandle Film Festival will host a weekend outdoor concert and film screening at at The HUM in Downtown Hickory on Saturday, September 23rd. The ticketed event will feature a concert by the Charlotte Bluegrass All-Stars, followed by a screening of the film **O BROTHER WHERE ART THOU?**, along with food trucks and beverage sales.

FOOTCANDLE SPECIAL PRESENTATIONS

September 16th: A special, 30th anniversary screening of the film **THE LAST OF THE MOHICANS** will take place at the Carolina Theater in Downtown Hickory. This film had much of its production take place in areas surrounding Hickory, with many in its cast and crew from our local community. This film screening will be a celebration of the film and will invite all cast and crew from the film to join and share their experiences in a discussion after the film.

In addition, the festival will host an additional two nights of special film screenings at the Carolina Theater to showcase films that were produced using previous years' Footcandle Filmmaking Grant funds. The two nights will be a combination of feature-length and short films, all made possible due to funding gathered from ticket sales for the previous years of the festival. The filmmakers will be in attendance for many of these screenings to discuss their films and the production process.

The goals of the Footcandle Film Festival are:

- To bring a collection of filmmakers from around the region, or around the world, to the Catawba County area, either inperson or through a virtual presence;
- To bring awareness of independent filmmaking and styles to the residents of Catawba County;
- To provide a weekend of interesting film screenings and discussions for both residents of Catawba County and visitors to the area;
- To create a showcase, high-profile event that would elevate Catawba County's artistic and cultural status in the region.
